## Yr 0 - 4

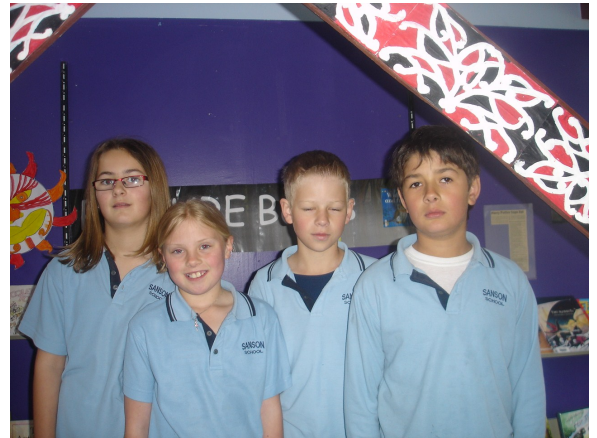
